

EASY WAY TO PERFORM UMRAH



PILLARS OF UMRAH

IHRAAM TAWAAF SA'I

HALAQ OR TAQSEER

(Full or little haircut)

IHRAAM

Intention to worship (Umrah) and wearing the clothes of Ihraam

Iski Sunnatain: Taking a bath - applying perfume on the head and body

NOTE: Ihram clothes should not be perfumed.








IHRAAM KA KAPDA

For Men: Two white sheets for men – one izaar (lungi) and the other upper (kamees)

For Women: Women may wear any clothing that is not prohibited by Shariat.







If it is time for the obligatory prayer, **perform** the obligatory prayer.

Otherwise, pray two rak'ahs with the intention of tahiyyatu wudu.

NOTE: There is no specific prayer for ihram.





Then make the intention and say, "Labbaik Umartaan"

لَبِيْكَ عُمْرَةً

And read Talbiyah

لَتَيْكَ اَللَّهُمَّ لَتَيْكَ، لَتَيْكَ لَا شَرِيْكَ لَكَ لَكَ لَكَ لَكَ اللَّهُمَّ لَكَ وَالْمُلْكُ، لَتَيْكَ، إِنَّا لَحُمْدَ وَالنِّعْمَةَ لَكَ وَالْمُلْكُ، لَا شَرِيْكَ لَكَ لَكَ لَا شَرِيْكَ لَكَ

It is better for a **man** to read loudly, but for a **woman** it is better to read softly and not raise her voice.



While entering the *Masjid Haram*, enter with your right foot first and recite this prayer

بشم اللهِ، وَالصَّلَاةُ وَالسَّلَامُ عَلَى رَسُولِ اللهِ، اللَّهُمَّ اغْفِرْ لِي ذُنُوبِي، وَافْتَحْ لِي أَبْوَابَ رَحْمَتِكَ، أَعُوذُ بِاللهِ الْعَظِيمِ، وَبوَجْهِهِ الْكَريمِ، وَسُلْطَانِهِ الْقَدِيمِ، مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجيمِ



Then go towards the **Black Stone** in the Ka'bah and start the Tawaf from there (there will be a green light in front of the Black Stone).





It is **Sunnah** for men to keep their right shoulder open during each round of Tawaaf,


and to perform *Raml* (walking quickly while keeping the steps close together) during the first three rounds.







There are 7 rounds of Tawaaf. Tawaaf should be started from *Hajre Aswad and should be completed by coming back there*. It is not correct to perform Tawaaf inside the stone wall (Hateem) which is towards the Ka'bah because it is a part of the Ka'bah.





If there is no crowd then kiss Hazre Aswad with your hands and kiss directly,

And if there is a crowd, then chew with your hands and chew your hands only,

And if this is not possible, then point with your hands towards the Black Stone from a distance and move ahead saying "Allahu Akbar".





Then if it is easy then touch the Rukne Yamani (don't kiss it), and if it is crowded then leave him.



Between rukne yamani and hajre aswad Read this supplication

﴿رَبَّنَا عَاتِنَا فِي ٱلدُّنْيَا حَسَنَةً وَفِي ٱلْآخِرَةِ حَسَنَةً وَقِنَا عَذَابَ ٱلنَّارِ ﴾





While passing through Hajr-e-Aswad, do the same as you did in the first round, and during Tawaaf, keep doing Zikr and Azkar, make Dua'in from Qasrat and remain busy in reciting the Quran.

NOTE: There is no special prayer for Tawaaf, there is no separate prayer for each cycle that has been proven by the Prophet.



After completing **Tawaaf**, go to **Maqaame Ibrahim** and recite these verses

﴿وَٱتَّخِذُواْ مِن مَّقَامِ إِبْرَاهِ عَم مُصَلَّى ﴾

Then two rak'at namaaz If possible, read it near the place of Ibraheem or read it anywhere. After **Surah Al-Fatihah** in the first rakat, read **Surah Al-Kafirun** and in the second, read **Surah Al-Ikhlas**.





Then go towards the place of *Mas'aah* (*Sa'i*), and when you are near Safaa, read this verse

﴿إِنَّ ٱلصَّفَا وَٱلْمَرُوةَ مِن شَعَآبِرِ ٱللَّهِ فَمَنُ حَجَّ ٱلْبَيْتَ أُو ٱعْتَمَرَ فَلَا جُنَاحَ عَلَيْهِ أَن يَطَّوَّ خَيْرًا فَإِنَّ أَن يَطَّوَّ خَيْرًا فَإِنَّ أَن يَطَّوَّ خَيْرًا فَإِنَّ اللَّهَ شَاكِرٌ عَلِيمٌ ﴾

Then climb the Safaa and turn your face towards the **Ka'bah** and make whatever prayer you wish.



It is Sunnah to pray for him.

لَا إِلَٰهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ، لَهُ الْمُلْكُ،
وَلَهُ الْحُمْدُ، وَهُوَ عَلَىٰ كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ،
لَا إِلَٰهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ، أَنْجَزَ وَعْدَهُ، وَنَصَرَ
عَبْدَهُ، وَهَزَمَ الْأَخْزَابَوَحْدَهُ


Teen martaba ise padhe aur jo dua karni ho kare





Then, from *Safaa*, walk down towards *Marwa* and run as fast as possible to the green light between the two *green pillars*.

NOTE: The **woman** will not run but will walk slowly.



The area of each round is 0.5 km and total is The distance of 7 rounds is 3.5 km



Then keep walking... When you reach *Marwa*, climb up and turn your face towards the Ka'bah and read what was written on the *Safaa*



Those who wish to pray between the days of **Safaa and Marwa** can do so, and there is no specific prayer.



After getting down from Marwa, come back to Safaa and complete 7 rounds in this manner, remember that from Safaa to Marwa is one round and from Marwa to Safaa is the second round, your Sati will be completed at Marwa.

During the Sa'i, pray a lot, remember Allah, and recite the **Quran** with devotion.

NOTE: There is no prayer after Sa'ee.



After the Saviour is complete, the man can get his head shaved or shave off the entire head (shaving is preferable).

And **women** should cut their hair equal to the size of one fingertip.





With these things, Umrah is completed, now the person performing Umrah will be completely halal and all the "prohibited things of Ihraam" (those things that were prohibited during the state of Ihraam) will become permissible for him.



May Allah Ta'ala bless all of us with the opportunity to visit His home, the Ka'bah, and grant our prayers the honor of acceptance.
